

“UK Is Reaping What It Has Sown”

Nearly four years ago, the University of Kentucky violated Kentucky law by beginning to pay the health insurance of the partners of homosexuals who worked for the University. violate the rules of eternal justice, trifle with the injunctions of morality, and recklessly destroy the political constitution which holds us together, no man can tell how sudden a catastrophe may overwhelm us and bury all our glory in profound obscurity.”
